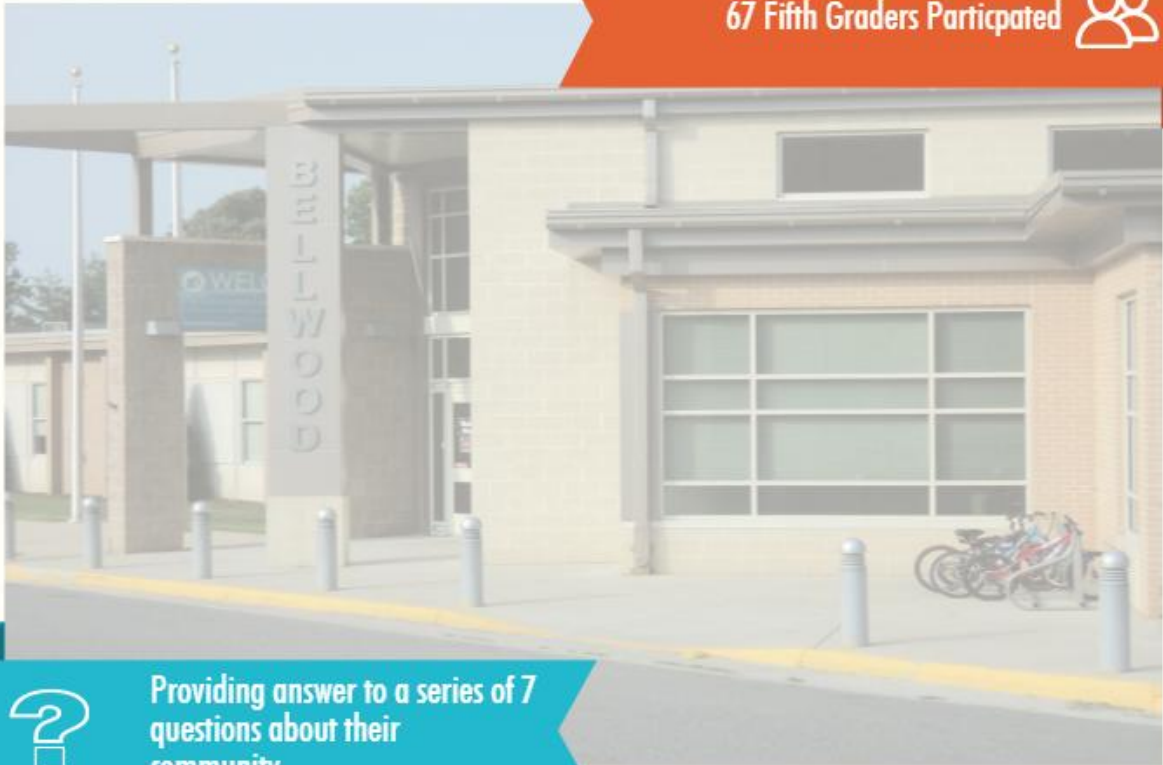


BELLWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

As a way to include participation and input from children in the community in the Northern Jefferson Davis Special Area Plan faculty and staff from Bellwood Elementary School developed a questionnaire for the school's fifth grade students to answer. The questionnaire provided an opportunity for the students to identify things that they like about their community and things that could be improved upon or changed. The following is a summary of the responses collected from 67 students.

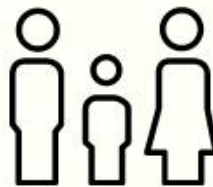
