

ON THE TRAILS

NEW TRAILS CREW FORMED

In December 2016, the Parks and Recreation Department moved two maintenance positions to form a Trails Crew. The crew is tasked with maintaining the 4.1 miles of trails in Chesterfield parks. The staff has been busy since that time with a variety of projects, see below. The department is excited to have a dedicated crew to address concerns and enhance the trail system.

Battery Dantzler:

- repaired hand rails
- trimmed back brush

Dutch Gap Conservation Area:

- started trimming back overgrowth on the trails

Government Center Trail:

- repaired one bridge
- installed a new bridge to stop water from washing out the trail
- replaced one culvert pipe and repaired the trail with stone dust
- stabilized the creek bank with old concrete

Radcliffe Conservation Area:

- repaired twelve boards on the boardwalk, need to replace more
- cut back the brush along the boardwalk and trails
- cut down seven dead trees

Robious Landing Park:

- replaced bridge on the blue trail
- replaced culvert pipe on the white trail
- fixed erosion on the white trail with rip-rap and stone dust
- fixed erosion with stone dust on trail by boat house and by Shelter 1 with the help of the World Mission Society Church of God

Ware Bottom Church:

- cut down 14 dead trees along the trail
