Project Description

The proposed project involves reconstructing the intersection of Matoaca Road (Route 600) and Hickory Road (Route 628) to improve safety and operations for the traveling public. The work includes constructing a roundabout at the existing four-way intersection. In addition to the roundabout, the roadway approaches will be improved, storm sewer and other drainage facilities installed, and utilities relocated to achieve the proposed design.

In addition to geometric roadway improvements, environmental impacts must also be considered. Minor wetland impacts and the removal of existing underground fuel storage tanks are required. All necessary permits will be applied for and approved prior to construction.

Overall, the project includes approximately 0.25 miles of roadway improvements, centered near the existing intersection. Minor traffic impacts are expected throughout the project and a short-duration detour will be implemented for one phase of construction.

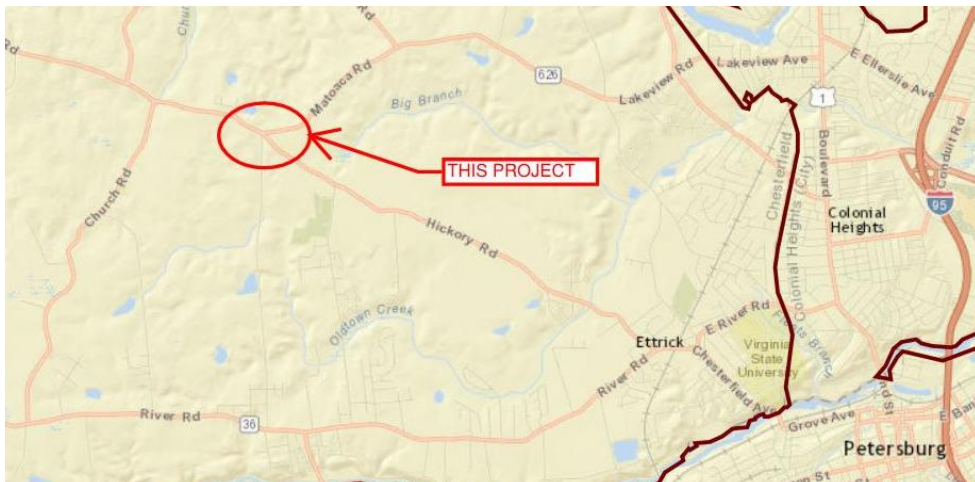
