Who we are: The Chesterfield County Department of Utilities is a public utility that uses state-of-the-art technology to deliver the highest quality service to its customers. The department provides water service to more than 112,000 customers and wastewater service to more than 95,000 customers in the county. It works with an annual operating budget of \$73.6 million, has 303 full-time positions, owns one water treatment plant and two wastewater-treatment plants, and controls 24 water-storage tanks and 39 pump stations.

What you will learn: The Environmental Protection Agency is revising the Lead and Copper Rule. This rule was established to protect public health by minimizing lead and copper levels in drinking water. You will work with a team consisting of an engineer, operations manager, plant manager and assistant director to create an inventory required by the proposed revisions of the Lead and Copper Rule and other duties related to the proposed revisions to the Lead and Copper Rule.

The Chesterfield Experience: As an intern in Chesterfield County, you will have an opportunity to meet with county leaders, collaborate with your peers, attend training seminars, and participate in team building exercises to complement what you will be learning in the professional work environment provided by the Utilities Department.

Minimum Qualifications: Candidates must be enrolled as current undergraduate or graduate students and have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.8. Must have completed college coursework in Business, Public Administration, Environmental Science or related field. Working knowledge in project management, planning and Excel required. The ability to analyze data, communicate effectively, and develop and maintain effective working relationships is required. Successful completion of a fingerprint-based criminal history check and pre-employment drug screen required.
