Chesterfield County representatives will hold a public hearing on the proposed Woolridge Road (Route 288 to Old Hundred Road) Extension Project. The proposed improvements include extending Woolridge Road approximately 1.2 miles from Route 288 to Old Hundred Road (Route 652). Multi-span bridges, intersection improvements and bicycle and pedestrian facilities are included in project scope.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, March 5, 2020 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Midlothian High School located at 401 Charter Colony Parkway, Midlothian, VA 23114. This informal meeting will provide an opportunity for individuals, businesses and organizations to give input on the project and review tentative project schedules. The meeting will be an Open House format and you may stop in any time between 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. to discuss and comment on the project. There will not be any formal presentation made at the meeting.
