Harrowgate Road & Cougar Trail:

The project involves the addition of a sidewalk and a wide outside travel lane along the east side of Harrowgate Road from Harrow Drive to Dogwood Avenue. A sidewalk will also be added to the north side of Cougar Trail from Harrowgate Road to Carver Middle School.

Harrowgate Road (Dogwood Avenue-South Street):

The project involves the addition of a sidewalk and a wide outside travel lane and along the east side of Harrowgate Road from the existing sidewalk near South Street to Dogwood Avenue.
