

To apply for voter registration and request absentee voting

1. Access the Department of Elections website: <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation>
2. Click **Register**

 - In order to Register to vote, change/update current voter registration information online, you must consent to the use of your DMV signature
 - Should you decline or not have a Virginia Identifier or Customer #, you can continue the request online; however, you will be prompted at the end to print, sign & date, and mail your application to your local Voter Registration Office

DMV Number Consent

To register online to vote, the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) must send the Virginia Department of Elections an electronic copy of the signature from your driver's license or state identification card. If you do not provide your full SSN and DMV ID and click "I Consent" below, you can continue to fill out this form, print it, sign it, and mail it to your General Registrar.

- Virginia does not register by party
- The June election is an open primary; however, there is only a dual primary in the 4th Congressional District. If you reside in the 4th Congressional District, you have the option of choosing either primary. If you reside in the 7th Congressional District, there is only a Republican Primary. Should you reside in the 7th Congressional District and choose June Democratic Primary, the request will be denied.
- Should you want to request a ballot for both the June Primary election and November General election, you will need to complete the process for the June Primary election and then submit another request for the November General election

11. Choose an **Absentee Ballot Reason** that best suits your situation, **click Next**

- Choose the **My disability or illness** option if you wish to avoid going to the polls on election day due to COVID-19

12. Enter **Voting Residence Address** information, **click Next**

13. Enter **Contact Information**, and **Additional Information** as it pertains to you, **click Next**

14. **Review Application** for accuracy, edit as necessary

15. Read and check the box under **Voter Registration Affirmation** and **Virginia Absentee Ballot Application Affirmation**, **click Submit**
