Dear Parents:

Chesterfield Juvenile Detention Home will be starting a limited visitation policy using our no-contact room effective Monday, May 18. Visitation times will be available throughout the week. Visitations must be scheduled in advance and will be limited to 45 minutes to allow time to sanitize the no-contact room after each use. The no-contact room will be sanitized after each resident and parent/legal guardian exits. Our no-contact room is located just inside the main entrance of our facility. NOTE: This is a different entrance from our parent visitation entrance. This entrance faces the street and there is a sign over the door that reads "MAIN ENTRANCE."

Visitation will only be open to parents/legal guardians at this time as the no-contact room can only accommodate two visitors. Each visitor will need to bring a picture ID and will be required to sign in. All other items must be left in your vehicle. Lockers are not available at our main entrance. You may bring money to put on your child's account.

If possible, we would prefer parents/legal guardians to have a standing time that is the same each week. Please arrive on time to utilize the entire visitation block. Visitation will end 45 minutes after the start of the visitation block. At this time, we will only offer one visitation block for each parent/legal guardian per week. If we can accommodate more visitations for all residents in the future, we certainly will. Residents will still be afforded the opportunity to make daily phone calls.

Parents/legal guardians of residents in treatment programs (Post-D or CPP) who wish to schedule a visitation time should contact the case manager of their child's program (Ms. McFarland for Post-D or Mr. Fraker for CPP). Parents/legal guardians of all other residents should call our main number and ask to speak with any supervisor or administrator. Contact information is listed below.

Please understand this is a new process for us and we may be working through some logistics. While visitation in a no-contact room is not ideal, we understand how important family engagement is for residents in our care, and we are excited to be able to offer this opportunity.
