To enroll in the Business of Co-Parenting class, a completed application packet consisting of the following items must be emailed to bricklem@chesterfield.gov by both parents:

3. Class fee \$50 [Submit payment here for Business of Co-Parenting](#)

Upon receiving the aforementioned items from **both parents**, a confirmation e-mail will be sent, indicating next steps, to comply with the court's order.

Registrations will stay active six months. If one co-parent chooses to not comply with court order in the time allotted, the courts will be notified of that co-parent's non-compliance and refund will be processed for the compliant co-parent.
