## TIPS FOR KEEPING ROADWAYS CLEAN AND SAFE

- Place trash/recycling cans close to your curb or ditch line. This is essential in preventing pedestrian, animal and vehicle accidents which keeps our roadways safe.
- Please don't overfill garbage container. Exposed garbage causes health issues and attracts rodents.
- Return empty garbage and recycling containers to the rear or side of your house the day of pickup. If you are away from home, ask a neighbor to do this for you.
- Curb appeal enhancement; check the appearance of your street frontage every few days. Please pick up any litter.
- Prevent road hazards by removing leaves, yard waste, grass clippings, and debris from your property ditch and roadway. This also reduces the risk of flooding. Avoid a Notice of Violation, Virginia Code 18.2-324.
