**New rates reflected on bills issued
on and after July 1, 2021**



Bimonthly Charges

Water and wastewater charges are billed bimonthly. Customer, capacity and commodity charges make up the total monthly bill. The customer and capacity charges equal the minimum charge for service regardless of the amount of water used. The commodity charges are determined by the metered water volume.

Bimonthly Rates

Bimonthly Customer Charge — \$10.16

Bimonthly Commodity Charge (volume charges)
per 100 cubic feet — water, \$2.25; wastewater, \$2.32

Bimonthly Capacity Charges for 5/8-inch meter —
water, \$15.90; wastewater, \$28.30.

How to Calculate Your Water and Wastewater Bill

This is an example only. The total bill may be higher or lower depending on the amount used. If you have questions about your specific bill or charges, call 804-748-1291.

Bimonthly bill based on a 5/8-inch meter using 14 CCF* of water (approximately 10,500 gallons)

** One CCF represents 100 cubic feet, or approximately 748 gallons of water.*

	Minimum Charge:
Customer Charge	\$10.16
Water Capacity Charge	\$15.90
Wastewater Capacity Charge	\$28.30
Total Minimum Charge	\$54.36
	Commodity Charge:
Water (14 CCF x \$2.25)	\$31.50
Wastewater (14 CCF x \$2.32)	\$32.48
Total Commodity Charge	\$63.98
Total Bill – Minimum and Commodity Charges	\$118.34

Wastewater-only customers — Residential customers connected to the county wastewater system, but not connected to the county water system, are charged \$70.94 per bimonthly billing.
