Chesterfield County representatives will hold a public meeting to provide an update on the proposed Henricus Park Public Access project and West Hundred Road (Rt. 10) project.

The Henricus Park Public Access project includes a new 1.7-mile local road from Henricus Park to Corporate Village Parkway in Meadowville Technology Park. This new two-lane roadway with multi-span bridges, and various bicycle, boating, and pedestrian facilities, to include new river access, are included in the Henricus Park Public Access project scope.

The West Hundred Road (Rt. 10) project construction is underway and includes road widening and safety improvements to West Hundred Road (Rt. 10).

The meeting will be held on Monday, November 1, 2021 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at John Tyler Community College, Chester Campus, Talley Workforce Center, Room N102A/B located at 1310 Jefferson Davis Highway, Chester, VA 23831. This informal meeting will provide an opportunity for individuals, businesses, and organizations to receive an update on the projects and review tentative schedules.
