Proposed Project:

This project includes the extension of Woolridge Road as a four-lane divided roadway with a sidewalk and shared-use-path from Route 288 to Old Hundred Road to connect to the existing two-lane section of Woolridge Road. A roundabout will be constructed at the intersection of Woolridge Road and Old Hundred Road. This project will involve a change and/or break in limited access control.
