The Bomb-Making Materials Awareness Program (BMAP) is a national program developed by the Department's Office for Bombing Prevention and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).

BMAP outreach materials are distributed by local law enforcement to local businesses to help employees more easily identify homemade explosives precursor chemicals and improvised explosive device (IED) components, and recognize suspicious purchasing behavior that could indicate potential bomb-making activities.

BMAP also encourages a stronger relationship between businesses and local law enforcement agencies, reinforcing the foundation of effective community safety and security.
