Interview and Interrogation begins with a review of communication basics:

- ♦ context and relational components
- ♦ verbal and non-verbal communication
- ♦ coding and encoding messages
- ♦ channels of communication
- ♦ “noise” that interferes with effective communication

Later, students explore the differences between interviews and interrogations and the how to prepare for each.

Students will strengthen existing skills or develop new ones through an examination of techniques such as Reid, neuro-linguistic programming, and kinesic analysis.

The class ends with two powerful exercises - Using skills and techniques discussed during the day, students evaluate the body language and statements of two suspects during their interviews with detectives. Ultimately both plead guilty, one will spend the rest of his life behind bars, and the other pays for his crime with his life.
